Ipasa Orphanages (Also known as Ipasa Homes) is a registered Non-governmental organization in [Tanzania](#), registered under *Non-Governmental Organizations Act 2002* (Reg. No. **11NGO/1203**).

Ipasa is a name of one of the suburbs in Ileje District, in [Mbeya](#) (South-Western Tanzania). It was randomly selected to christen this endeavor of taking care of and rehabilitating children in need of care. Children that we target are mostly those orphaned by HIV AIDS, and some of them still live with the HIV virus.

The founders of Ipasa Homes are Daniel and Irene Musokwa helped by a team of 10 stakeholders and board members from various professions and callings.



The reason Ipasa Homes was founded was to meet the needs of a great number of children orphaned by HIV AIDS in the [city of Mbeya](#). But increasingly, we are currently helping destitute parents, especially single parents, who need help in caring for orphaned children.

Part of the concert proceeds from the upcoming concert, and future concerts, will be used to support Ipasa Orphanages.
